
We believe that the best kind of learning is that is beyond those four walls and being pioneers in media education, our intent is to provide best quality education to every student.


RAJESH KHANNA

He starred in 15 consecutive solo hit films from 1969 to 1971, still an unbroken record. He did 106 solo hero films of which 97 were released between 1967 to 2013.
